If there are few entries per category, the organizing committee reserves the right to merge categories.

Tapes, CDs:	Regular tapes (rewound) and CDs are permitted. A separate tape/CD is to be used for each competitor. Each tape/CD may only contain the piece of music of the respective competitor. All tapes/CDs (including the case) must clearly indicate the name and first name as well as skating club of the competitor.
